## **TO ALL MEMBERS**

### **9<sup>th</sup> National Conference of the Federation - A Scintillating Success**

We are happy to inform you that the 9<sup>th</sup> National Conference of our Federation took place on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at “Keshav Dham”, Keshav Nagar, Rukmini Vihar, Vrindaban, Distt. Mathura (U.P.), as notified.

The Conference was preceded by the Central Committee Meeting of the Federation held in the morning of 11<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at the same venue.

### **Inaugural Session:**

At about 5.30 p.m. all the guests, office bearers of the Federation, delegates, observers, and the friends from the media gathered in the Auditorium at 5<sup>th</sup> floor of Keshav Dham. An epoch making Inaugural Session was started at about 6.00 pm with active and enthusiastic participation of more than 400 delegates and observers.

First of all ‘Brij Ki Malhar’ and ‘Bhajan Sandhya’ programme was presented by Shri Deepak Diwana and his team wherein so many members moved to the gallery in front of the dais and danced in devotion to Lord Banke Bihari Ji and Goddess Radha Ji which continued till the arrival of the Inaugurator Shri S.P. Singh Baghel, Hon’ble Minister of State for Law and Justice, Government of India in the auditorium who has come from Goa and reached directly to the venue from New Delhi Airport.

The Inaugural Session commenced with the invitation of the President and General Secretary of the Federation, Inaugurator Shri S.P. Singh Baghel- Hon’ble Minister of State for Law and Justice, Government of India, Chief Guest Shri Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish- General Secretary, National Confederation of Bank Employees and Convener United Forum of Bank Unions, Guest of Honour Shri Vinil Saxena- President, All India Bank of Baroda Employees Federation and Shri S.D. Mishra- Chairman, All India Union Bank Staff Federation and Shri Y.K. Sharma President, National Confederation of Bank Employees (Uttar Pradesh) to the dais to the accompaniment of cheers which delighted the guests and the audiences.

The Inaugurator Shri S.P. Singh Baghel- Hon’ble Minister of State for Law and Justice inaugurated the Conference by lighting the lamp before Lord Banke Bihari Ji to the accompaniment of ‘Stuti’(prayer) of Lord Banke Bihari Ji.

Thereafter, Shri Dileep Goyal presented the welcome address to the Inaugurator, Chief Guest and all other dignitaries on the dais, delegates, observers and all the media persons present there.

Hon'ble Minister Shri S.P. Singh Baghel, in his inaugural address said that the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has extra ordinary faith on the bank employees, thereby they have been chosen by him for implementation of all the public welfare schemes launched by the central government i.e. Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojna, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Beema Yojna, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Beema Yojna, Direct LPG Subsidy Transfer Scheme, Atal Pension Yojna, Sukanya Samriddhi Yojna, PM Awas Yojna and Mudra Rhin Yojna, Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) etc.

Shri S.P. Singh Baghel, further said that the Prime Minister has all praise to bank employees for the tremendous work done by them in opening crores of accounts within a very limited period under Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojna and collecting huge amount as deposits in these accounts and also in making the Demonetisation Scheme a scintillating success.

Chief Guest Shri Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish in his address said that the banks are the back bone of the economy of the country and our organization NCBE, being an independent and non-political workmen trade union of Indian Banking Industry always remained instrumental in maneuvering the trade union movement of bank employees from the political clutches.

He further said that if the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi shown his faith upon the bank employees, the bank employees have also done a remarkable work by opening more than 18 crore accounts in Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojna, by collecting the amount of Rs.32000 crores in these accounts and by implementing all the schemes of the Central Government with great zeal and high spirit.

Shri Vinil Kumar Saxena, President, All India Bank of Baroda Employees Federation in his address said that running a minority union is a very difficult task but despite so many hurdles All India PNB Staff Federation has done a remarkable job for the betterment of its members under the present leadership.

Shri S. D. Mishra, Chairman, All India Union Bank Staff Federation in his address said that the successive governments in the name of reforms are trying to change the basic character of Public Sector Banks. He further said that at present the outsourcing of banking jobs and shortage of staff at counters are the main challenges before the bank employees.

Shri R. K. Sharma, General Secretary of the Federation shown his serious concern over late delivery/denial of justice and non availability of proper health services to the poor and middle class citizens of the country as in both the cases the fees being charged by the lawyers and doctors is out of their reach and requested the Hon'ble Minister to look into the problems being faced by the poor and middle class citizens in getting justice.

The General Secretary also advised the members to always remember the credence earned by their great leaders, not to forget their duties while demanding for their just rights and to maintain the sanctity of the symbol of their union wherein the two sides of a balance named 'Rights and Duties' are balanced by the nib of a pen.

He also urged the members to implement at one hand all the programmes of NCBE and UFBU and on the other hand all the programmes and schemes of the Bank and the Government with high spirit.

Thereafter, Shri Dheeraj Kumar Bisht and Shri Deepak Kumar were honoured by Shri Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary, NCBE and Convenor, UFBU on behalf of the house for the valuable efforts made by them in unprecedented growth of Federation in Uttrakhand and Punjab.

At the end, President Shri D.P. Verma presented the vote of thanks and the Inaugural Session came to an end.

### **Delegate Session:**

The Delegate Session of the Conference was started with active and enthusiastic participation of more than 200 delegates from all over the country at about 10.30 a.m. on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

In Delegate Session Audited Statements of Accounts of the Federation since the last conference upto the year 2021 and for the period from 01.01.2022 to 31.05.2022 as passed by the Central Committee were presented which were unanimously approved by the house.

Thereafter, an amendment to the Constitution and Rules of the Federation, as recommended by the Central Committee was placed before the house. The house approved the same without any change.

After this, the General Secretary placed his report since the last conference till date as passed by the Central Committee mentioning therein all the achievements and failures of the Federation on various issues, detailed Report Card on the guidance and assistance provided by the Federation to its affiliates and their members as and when desired to resolve their issues and to solve the problems faced by them.

He urged upon the members to go closer to the people and explain to them as to how people's interests are protected by the bank employees as a perception is being developed day-by-day in the minds of the people that they are not cared for or sympathized by the bank employees.

He exhorted to launch a determined struggle against the evil of corruption. He also apprised about other burning issues of immediate concern to the bank employees more particularly the employees of Punjab National Bank.

The house discussed at length on all the issues finalized by the Central Committee and also on the new issues raised by the delegates. A long and lively discussion took place on all the issues, the approach to be adopted by the Federation and its stand on the issues. After prolonged discussions the house adopted resolutions on the following issues:-

**Demanding:**

1. Updation of Pension
2. Absorption of all Temporary Employees/Casual Workers
3. Removal of Cap on Allocation of Funds for Staff Welfare
4. Appointment on Compassionate Grounds
5. Charge of need based amount of cash be given to officiating Head Cashiers where it is not possible for them to count entire cash before taking charge
6. Permission to Enter Union Membership through 'Employee Self Service'
7. Full Train Fare be Paid on Encashment of LFC of Senior Citizen Parents
8. Medical Aid to Workmen Employees be Revised in tune with Officers
9. Old Pension Scheme be Restored for the all those Covered under NPS
10. Medical Insurance Premium of Retirees should be borne by the Banks
11. Conversion of all Part Time Employees in Full Time Employees
12. Reimbursement of Petrol Expenses/Payment of Fixed Amount on account of Conveyance Expenses to Workmen during First year of their Service
13. Payment of 1% Additional Rate of Interest in Staff Related Accounts
14. Scheme of Interest Free Festival Advance to the Retirees of the Bank
15. Release of Benefits of 9<sup>th</sup> Stagnation Increment to Eligible Retirees

**Opposing:**

1. Amendments to Labour Laws
2. Non Performing Assets
3. Shortage of Workmen Staff
4. Anomaly in Payment of Pension to Retirees whose 9<sup>th</sup> Stagnation increment becomes due from the date which falls less than 10 months prior to their date of Superannuation/ Removal/Dismissal from the Service of the Bank
5. Disinvestments in Public Sector Undertakings
6. Government's Move to Privatise Public Sector Banks
7. Permitting MetLife Insurance Employees to sit on the Counters.

Now, it was the turn of election of members to the National Executive and Central Committee of the Federation. At this, Shri D.P. Verma President appealed the house to elect someone else to the post of the President of the Federation and to relieve him from the highest chair of the Federation taking into consideration his health problems.

The house accepted the offer of Shri D.P.Verma of leaving the post of the President of the Federation with heavy hearts. Entire house praised the services rendered by him to the employees of Punjab National Bank during last five decades in one voice and appealed him to continue rendering his services in future also as a path provider to the Federation and resolved to proffer him whole life Central Committee membership of the Federation.

The house proffered honorary membership to Shri Anil Kumar Vidyarathi and Shri Priya Vrat Sharma, in addition to honorary membership already proffered to Shri N.K. Tripathi.

After this, the house unanimously elected the members to the National Executive and Central Committee of the Federation.

The National General Council enhanced the unity of the organization. It fortified members to face future with great determination. It spelt out loudly and clearly that All India PNB Staff Federation should fight for the cause of the members, where necessary, collectively.

The General Secretary thanked all the delegates and the entire membership of the affiliated unions for entrusting him once again with the responsibility of running the office of the General Secretary of the Federation, offered his hearty congratulations to all the members elected to the National General Council and Central Committee and wish them all well in their new assignments.

He assured the house that he will strain every nerve and do his best to champion the cause of PNB employees and improve their lot by overcoming all kinds of limitations and obstacles with the whole hearted co-operation of one and all at all levels. He requested all the affiliates and members to extend their best co-operation to the new team of Office Bearers and Central Committee Members for effective functioning of the organization.

At the end, President Shri D.P. Verma in his address profusely thanked the members for showering respect, love and affection throughout his long tenure at the helm of the organization, for actively participating in the deliberations and accepting his appeal to relieve him from the post of the President of the Federation and conveyed thanks to the Reception Committee on behalf of the house for making excellent arrangements for successful conduct of the Conference.
